TRANSFERS by Junior Handlers from Novice to Open Class MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. SUBSTITUTIONS of Junior Showmanship dogs must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show.

**EXHIBITORS NOTE:**

**Ramps may be used** in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).

**NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.**

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

**Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**All Dogs Present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**No gasoline or diesel generators** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**NORTH - From Sterling; Leominster; and Fitchburg:** Route 12 South to I-190 South, to I-290 West; off at Exit 16, turn right, follow signs to the Centrum.

**From Nashua and Manchester, New Hampshire:** Route 3 South to I-495 South, to I-290 West, off at Exit 16, turn right, follow signs to the Centrum.

**NORTHEAST - From Marlborough; Lowell; Lawrence; Haverhill; and Portsmouth, New Hampshire:** I-495 South to I-290 West, off at Exit 16 turn right, follow signs to the Centrum.

**EAST - From Framingham; Wellesley; Newton; Cambridge; and Boston:** Mass Pike (I-90) West, off at Exit 10 Auburn, to I-290 East, off at Exit 16 East Central Street, turn left, follow the signs to the Centrum.
