IMPORTANT - TRANSFER of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch. 11 Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Grooming will be conducted in the designated grooming rooms only. Please clean up after yourself and your dog(s).

All crates must be stacked in the grooming areas.

Crates will be permitted in the Ballroom only while your breed is being judged and at the discretion of the Show Committee.

Exercise pens will be permitted in designated areas only. Exercise areas will be clearly marked and enforced. Please clean up after your dog(s).

Dogs entered at this show MUST have up to date rabies and shot records available.

Small Dogs only allowed on show grounds.

Limited RV camping permitted. Guests staying in the hotel may park for free. RV camping reservation must be submitted and prepaid at \$30.00 per night. No Hook-ups are available. Form is in back of the judging program.

Food will be available.

No dogs permitted in public restrooms.

No space for unentered dogs.
