DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

FROM NORTH AND SOUTH VIA I 295--I 295 TO Exit 65A, Sloane Ave. Go East on Sloane Ave. to first traffic light, Quaker Bridge Road. Cross Quaker Bridge Road and go to next traffic light (road makes a T) at Old Trenton/Edinburg Road. Mercer County Park is about 2 miles ahead on the left.

FROM SOUTH VIA US ROUTE 1—Cross toll bridge into NJ. On US 1 make first right past Quaker Bridge Mall onto Quaker Bridge Road (Rt. 533). Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Hughes Drive. Make left at traffic light onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road (Rt. 535) and proceed to entrance 112 miles on the left.

FROM SOUTH VIA ROUTE 1301206—Follow Rt.130 North to Rt. 526 in Robbinsville. Turn left at traffic light onto Rt. 526 (Corners: Coastal Gas Station, Russert's Deli, Bon Vivant Liquors). Turn right at the next traffic light; you are still on Rt. 526. Travel 3 miles to Rt. 535, Old Trenton/Edinburg Road and turn left. The exhibit's entrance to the showgrounds is about 113 of a mile ahead on the right side.

FROM NORTH VIA US 1—Take US 1 South of Princeton to Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Bear right off US 1 into jughandle and cross over US 1 onto Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Travel 2.2 miles then turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Old Trenton/Edinburg Road. Rt. 535. Travel about 1 1/2 miles to entrance to the Park on the left.

FROM NORTH VIA NJ TURNPIKE —NJ Turnpike South to Exit 8, Hightstown Follow Rt. 33 West (Franklin St.) and turn left at the second traffic light (road makes a T) and a quick right turn at the first traffic light (center of town's business district) onto Rt. 571, Stockton St. Cross over Rt. 130 and follow Rt. 571, Hightstown-Princeton Rd. Go to the first traffic light at Rt. 130 light. Turn left onto Rt. 535, Old Trenton/Edinburg Rd. There are no road signs here that indicate Rt. 535, but the landmarks at the corner are a bank on the right, a garden center on the near left and a Getty Gas station on far left of Rt. 535. Travel on Rt. 535 through 2 traffic lights to the exhibit's entrance to the Park on right-- about 4 1/2 miles ahead.

FROM SOUTH VIA NJ TURNPIKE —NJ Turnpike North to Exit 7A. Take I-195 West to Exit 5B which is the first exit on Rt. 195 to Rt. 130 North, New Brunswick. Travel north on Rt. 130 to second traffic light and turn left onto Rt. 526. Proceed to the next traffic light and turn right (still Rt. 526). Go 3 miles to Rt. 535 and turn left. The Park's exhibit's entrance is 113 of a mile ahead on the right.

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog (including \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee), and \$18.00 for each additional entry of the same Dog. The Friday Sweepstakes entry fee is \$10.00.

CLOSING DATE for entries 5:00 P.M., Wednesday, April 19, 2006 (at Show Secretary's Office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

A RECORDING FEE of \$.50 and an **AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE** of \$1.50 will be required for each Dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a Dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section2).

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of the returned check.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY

Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT acceptable.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable. SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR within a reasonable time, please notify Jeff Beyer, Show Secretary, 908-781-2630.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a Dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from Competition by action of Show Committee. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for any errors made on entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or of the cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a Dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled judging times. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their Dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The Show-giving Club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of Dogs and Exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either Dogs or Exhibitors participating in this Show.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
