Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show;
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show.
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.
- In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

9. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NR2.383. Parade of Title Holders, Veterans & Rescue Dogs - Non-Competitive Class. **No entry fee.** Please prepare a short paragraph about the dog to be announced in the ring (**See page 2 for more information**).

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

NR2.091. Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed.

NR2.092. Brood Bitch Class - The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog & Produce for Get.

NR2.093. Brace - Two Dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. **Entry fee is \$25.00 for the Brace as a unit as a first entry and \$18.00 as a unit as an additional entry.**

NR2.094. Team Class - (Four Dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of four handlers.) The dogs comprising a Team must be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team Class Only." In making entries for "Team Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Team **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Team Class." There will no additional fee for Team Classes if more than one Team is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each team must be so designated, "Team No. 1", "Team No. 2", etc. **Entry fee is \$25.00 for the Team as a unit as a first entry and \$18.00 as a unit as an additional entry.**

As the judge's decision in these Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

HOTEL RULES FOR DOGS AND PEOPLE

Any sleeping room with a dog in it will be charged the damage deposit and subject to the following rules. No exceptions for unentered dogs. (Federal, State and local laws regarding service dogs apply.)

1. No dogs in hotel lobby, use back and side entrances.
2. No dogs inside the fenced pool areas.
3. No dogs in restaurant or hospitality rooms where food is being served.
4. Observe, and obey all signs posted designating areas where dogs are and are not allowed.
5. Place plastic under dog crates in the hotel sleeping rooms.
6. All persons leaving dogs in rooms must provide a cell phone contact, and a secondary cell phone contact so that if a dog is creating a disturbance or in distress the owner may be contacted. This will be done at time of check-in.
7. No unattended loose dogs in sleeping rooms. All dogs in sleeping rooms must be crated when owner is not in room.
8. All dogs must be on a leash or in a crate unless they are in the ring or in an attended sleeping room.
9. Absolutely no dog grooming or bathing in sleeping rooms. Use assigned bathing and grooming areas.
10. Barking or howling dogs in sleeping rooms must be attended to. It is recommended that a radio or TV is left on while owners are away to keep dogs from howling or barking.
11. When exercising dogs owners must clean up immediately, and dispose of dog waste in appropriate containers.
12. No soft crates in grooming areas.
13. If grooming area becomes crowded exhibitors may be asked to stack crates.
14. All exhibitors and observers will be asked to help keep grooming and exhibition area clean.
15. Dogs in unattended vehicles must have proper ventilation and temperature control. The police will be called if a dog is observed to be in distress in an unattended vehicle.
16. Private x-pens may be set up in designated areas only.
17. All minor children must be supervised. The hotel, CSCA and CSFM do not provide child care.

Anyone not following above rules may be asked to leave by hotel management, and may forfeit any deposits, cleaning fees or room charges. Persons violating above rules may also be subject to an hearing by the Event Hearing Committee in accordance with AKC rules and regulations.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
