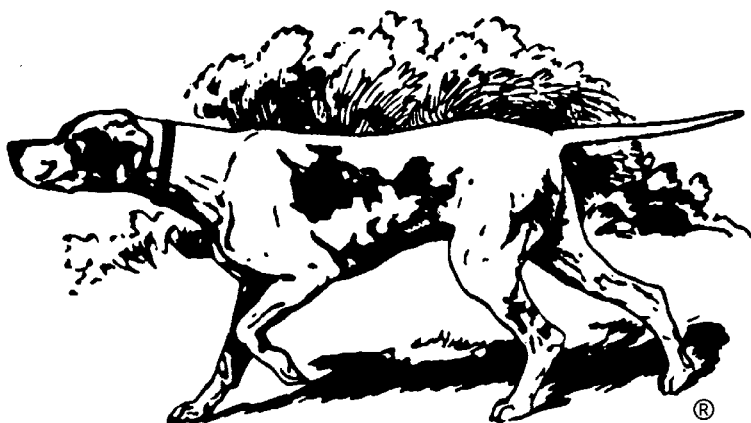


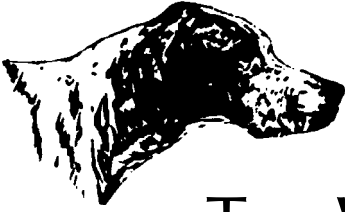

The benching of dogs is an integral part of this show. The Rules regarding benching will be strictly enforced. In addition, dogs are presumed to be under the care, custody and control of the person(s) listed on the entry form. Neglect of a dog on the bench could result in an Event Committee Hearing.

Release times are published in the judging program and are enforced. Dogs WILL NOT be released from the building without the appropriate signed release form. **There will be no one available to furnish release forms after 9:00 P.M. E.T. Friday, Saturday and Sunday. If you do not have your dog's admittance ID/Release form for Monday and Tuesday nights it must be obtained prior to 11:00 P.M. E.T. Abuse of the Guards will not be tolerated. It is your responsibility to have the appropriate release forms and to vacate the building before the ramp and elevator closing hours.**

ENTRY RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB ALL BREED DOG SHOW February 15 & 16, 2010

The Westminster Kennel Club has a number of specific rules and procedures. **Please read this entire document carefully. Failure to comply with the rules, regulations, requirements or procedures of this club will result in exclusion from this show.**

SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS:

INVITATIONS TO PRE-ENTER: As in the past, the Top Five dogs (AKC Champions) in breed standings for the period January 1, 2009 – October 31, 2009 (inclusive) are invited to pre-enter in advance of the regular closing date. The Top 5 invitees will receive via regular First Class postal mail, a Certificate of Eligibility, along with a pre-printed entry form and a return envelope. Please follow the instructions on the reverse of the pre-printed entry form. ***See also Complete Entry Rules and Procedures.***

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (PLEASE NOTE PROCEDURES): Juniors who have won 10 (Ten) or more Firsts in the Open Classes for Junior Showmanship (Competition Required) at AKC Licensed or Member shows held between November 1, 2008 - October 31, 2009 (inclusive) and who were at least 9 years of age and under 18 years of age at the time of the wins, are invited to enter the Junior Showmanship Limited Class at this show. Each eligible Junior will receive via regular First Class postal mail, a Certificate of Eligibility, along with a blank entry form and return envelope. Please follow the instructions on the reverse of the pre-printed entry form. Only those Juniors whose names appear on this list are eligible for entry into this show. ***See Complete Entry Rules and Procedures and pages 10-11, and pages 14-20. DO NOT SEND A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM FOR A JUNIOR WHO IS SHOWING AN INVITED DOG OR A NON-INVITED BEST OF BREED/VARIETY DOG.*** If a dog is entered in breed and Juniors and the breed limit is reached the valid Junior portion of the entry is still acceptable.

SUBMISSION DATES FOR ALL ENTRIES: Once the Top 5 list and the eligible Juniors list is posted on the Westminster and InfoDog websites, or beginning November 16, 2009, whichever is earliest, Best of Breed/Variety entries (both Invited and non-Invited) and Invited Junior Showmanship entries may be sent **via any traditional postal service that will deliver to a P.O. Box and DOES NOT REQUIRE A SIGNATURE FOR DELIVERY OR through infodog.com** at any time to be received no later than 3:00 P.M. (ET) Friday, December 4, 2009. **NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED THAT REQUIRES A SIGNATURE FOR DELIVERY. NO Entries, for other than Invited dogs, Invited Juniors exhibiting Invited dogs or Invited Junior Showmanship Only, will be processed prior to 8:00 A.M. (ET) on Friday, December 4, 2009.** As in the past, all other entries will be accumulated in random order until all invitees have been processed. (Please see Junior Showmanship above and on pages 10-11 and pages 14-20 for Complete Entry Rules and Procedures.)

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES: All entries must be submitted to P.O. Box 22067, Greensboro, NC 27420 ONLY. Please indicate on the outside of the envelope whether the entry contained therein is Invited, Junior Only, Breed or Breed/Junior, etc.

Entries may be submitted by: The owner, the owner's duly authorized agent (the person responsible for the dog at the show), or through an established, legal entry service (whose normal business is the taking and submitting of dog show entries), OR through our Superintendent's entry service infodog.com. *If an exhibitor utilizes infodog.com to submit an entry for our show, the time of submission of the entry online has no bearing on when, or if, the entry is accepted into the show.* InfoDog online entries will be printed and placed in the postal box with a check just as all other entries for our show.

There is a limit of one entry per envelope. Envelopes with more than one entry will be returned. **All entries submitted to the P.O. Box must be accompanied by a check or money order, each payable in U.S. Funds. NO CREDIT CARDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** No matter how an entry service takes payment for an entry from their customer, they must submit an individual check with each individual entry form. Checks or money orders returned for ANY reason will cause the entry to be removed from the show with no recourse.

*** DELIVERY METHODS:** Entries may be submitted via any traditional postal service that will deliver to a P.O. Box and DOES NOT REQUIRE A SIGNATURE FOR DELIVERY. **FAX, Dial-N-Entry®, Courier, walk-ins or entries handed in at shows are NOT acceptable or permitted.** NOTE: Entrants should be aware that pieces sent requesting a postal service "Delivery Confirmation" are scanned at the time they come off the truck at the postal facility NOT at the time they are delivered to the P.O. Box. The scanned time indicates only that it arrived at the facility. **See also Complete Entry Rules and Procedures.**

DUPLICATE ENTRIES: Duplicate entries and fees received into processing PRIOR to the closing of entries, or prior to the limit being reached if reached prior to the closing date and time, **WILL NOT BE RETURNED.** For 2010, a portion of these proceeds will be donated to The Westminster Kennel Club Junior Scholarship Awards. Entries and fees received into processing AFTER the close of entries, or after the limit is reached if reached prior to the closing date and time, will be returned.

Entries for an invited dog may be sent as soon as the list is posted or beginning November 16, 2009, whichever is earliest. **Entries sent prior to that time will be returned.** A Memento Certificate acknowledging the Top 5 status qualifying the dog's eligibility to be invited to enter, along with a pre-printed entry form and a return envelope, will be sent in mid-November via regular First Class postal mail to the owner at the address on file with our Superintendent. Please follow the instructions on the reverse of the pre-printed entry form. **No entry will be accepted that requires a signature for delivery.**

Juniors who have placed First in 10 (ten) or more Open Classes in Junior Showmanship (competition required) at AKC Licensed or Member shows held between November 1, 2008 and October 31, 2009 (inclusive) will receive a Memento Certificate of Eligibility along with a blank entry form and return envelope to enter. If not found until after show, all awards will be subject to cancellation by the American Kennel Club. There will be no dogs added to replace those dogs found to be ineligible. Junior Showmanship ONLY dogs need not be champions. **See pages 5-6 & 10-11 for Junior Information.**

10. **Non-Invitation Best of Breed/Variety entries, Non-Invitation that include Invited Juniors as an additional class, and Invited Junior Showmanship Only entries must be mailed to P.O. Box 22067, Greensboro, NC 27420 ONLY,** according to the noted requirements at any time beginning when the Top 5 and qualifying Junior invitees list is posted, or beginning November 16, 2009, whichever is earliest. **BUT MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 3:00 P.M., E.T., FRIDAY, DECEMBER 4, 2009.** Non-Invitation Best of Breed/Variety entries or non-invitational Best of Breed/Variety entries that include Juniors as an additional class, postmarked prior to the date the list is posted, or prior to November 16, 2009, whichever is earliest, will be returned.
11. **DUPLICATE ENTRIES: Duplicate entries and fees received into processing PRIOR to the closing of entries, or prior to the limit being reached if reached prior to the closing date and time, WILL NOT BE RETURNED. For 2009, a portion of these proceeds will be donated to The Westminster Kennel Club Junior Scholarship Awards. Entries and fees received into processing AFTER the close of entries, or after the limit is reached if reached prior to the closing date and time, will be returned.**
12. **Benching Forms must be submitted ONLY if you have multiple dogs that need to be benched together in their Breed Section, or, if you have a dog that is to be benched in the Multi-Breed section with your handler.** Completed Benching Forms may be submitted at any time up to 3:00 P.M., E.T., Friday, December 4, 2009 via any method. **Failure to provide complete or accurate information on the benching form could result in your dog being benched differently than you wish with no recourse.** Single dogs benched in the Breed Section do not need to submit the benching form. You may submit your benching form at the time you submit your entry. You may submit it separately through the postal mail to the address listed in this premium list, or the complete benching information may be forwarded via e-mail or fax to the MB-F North Carolina office noted in items on pages 5-6. Please indicate in the space provided on the benching form whether you wish to be in the regular Breed Benching or wish to be in the Multi-Breed section with your handler. **In order to be eligible for Multi-Breed benching you must meet the requirements listed on pages 20,26-27 of this premium list. All dogs to be benched together in ANY area must be appropriately noted on the Benching Form submitted to MB-F. Be sure before listing a handler's name on your entry. If you are using the services of a handler qualified for Multi-Breed benching and change handlers after the entries close you are not assured of being in the Multi-Breed benching or having the correct handler's name listed in the catalog.**
13. **NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS Rules Applying to Dog Shows Effective January 1, 2010, CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.** No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. **See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.**

14. ***“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”***
15. Please review your entry form prior to submitting. Incorrect information submitted could result in the disallowance of a win or in not permitting the dog to be shown. The printed show catalog is distributed world-wide and incorrect information submitted would be reprinted by the press or portrayed in other media. Owners are responsible for such errors no matter who submits the information. **Once entries are closed, AKC DOES NOT ALLOW any correction to the entry information other than a correction to the sex of the dog.**
16. Once entries close all entries that include a valid e-mail address on their entry form will receive an e-mail Notice of Receipt of Entry pending AKC validation of their championships and proper registration. A Notice of Receipt of Entry will also be mailed First Class via the U.S. Postal Service. **There will be no entry confirmation over the telephone. Any inquiries must be in writing giving dog’s breed, name, AKC# and whether dog is invited, a non-invited or Junior Showmanship dog entry. Inquiries by postal mail or e-mail (MB-F2@infodog.com) only.**
17. After the closing time no entries will be accepted, cancelled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed (exception AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6) and no entry fee refunded. Telephoned or telegraphed entries, conditional entries, and/or **photocopied entries without the AKC agreement on the back are not acceptable.** All changes, completions, cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING** before closing. Cancellations or Changes must include the dog’s registration number, breed & name.
18. This Club and/or its Superintendents assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner, or a legal entry service engaged by the owner, nor for the owner or the owner’s agent or legal entry service entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, nor for entering the same dog twice, nor for entering the wrong dog.
19. Fees payable in U.S. Funds must accompany entries. Returned and Post Dated checks or money orders do not constitute an entry fee. **Any entry that has a returned or post dated check or money order will be returned.** No dogs will be added to replace these entries. **See also pages 5-6.**
20. Entry fees are NOT refunded when a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for bitches in season or for duplicate entries. **See also pages 5-6.**
21. **The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.**
22. No entry fees are returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, wars, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions, fire and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner of the grounds and/or facilities or any other cause beyond the control of The Westminster Kennel Club, nor shall Madison Square Garden Corporation or the Superintendent be liable in any way. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

EXHIBITOR TICKET INFORMATION

1. Regardless of the ownership of the dog(s) one exhibitor's gate admission is sent for each dog entered. The gate admission is valid for both days of the show and is needed for admittance. The person accompanying the dog must show an admission ticket and the dog identification before the dog will be admitted. **DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED.** There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show. **Exhibitors must preserve their dog identifications which must be surrendered when dogs are removed from the show.**
2. All tickets, dog ID's, etc., are sent to the address noted on the entry form. Owners or the owners' duly authorized agent are responsible for the correctness. No duplicate packets may be mailed.
3. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" are held at the Superintendent's Office.

JUDGING

1. The judging starts promptly. During the hours of judging exhibitors are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly.
2. The owner of the dog or the handler is responsible for the presence of their dog in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring.
3. **All cell phones, pagers, beepers, etc. must be on "mute" or "vibrate" when in the ring area. Persons with ringing or toning cell phones, pagers, beepers, etc. will be escorted from the ring area. No cell phone photos/videos are permitted.**
4. **Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge**, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden & Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. (Whippets may be examined on the ground, on a table or on a ramp.)

Basset Hounds are expected to be judged on ramp during breed judging.

This list may be revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations. **A judge requesting** the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

TROPHIES

1. Trophies and prizes are awarded in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who is considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. **All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before completion of the judging of the breed and the Superintendent's office advised at once of any discrepancy.** The Superintendent and the Show-giving Club disclaim any liability for prizes or trophies after the judging of that breed is over.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

1. The Management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or property of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the time the dog is on the show premises. See also the agreement on the reverse of the entry form.
2. The welfare of an exhibitor's/spectator's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor/spectator. It is expressly understood that exhibitors/spectators will exercise control and restraint over their children while they are on the show premises.
3. The Westminster Kennel Club and its Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and

escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

EQUIPMENT

1. The Club and its Superintendent provide assistance to exhibitors and handlers in unloading and placing their crates and grooming tables. Crate and grooming areas will be arranged in rows and aisles to facilitate exhibitors and to expedite the safe and smooth operation of the show. By entering this show, exhibitors and handlers agree to follow all directions of the special assistants charged with arranging and maintaining orderly conditions in these areas. Abuse of these assistants will not be tolerated.
2. **Grooming tables in excess of 24 x 36 inches are not permitted. Tables must be folded when not in use. Grooming of dogs in areas other than the grooming and Multi-Breed benching section is not permitted. Tack Units in Multi-Breed benching area must be on the bench.**
3. **No Flexi/retractable leads permitted at this show.**
4. **Fabric crates are not permitted at this show.**
5. **No private exercise pens are allowed anywhere in the show precincts. Public exercise pens will be for multiple dogs at all times. Dogs must be on lead in exercise pens. No exceptions. A separate area will be provided for bitches in season. Owners/handlers are to clean-up after their dogs. Blocking off exercise pens is NOT permitted.**
6. **No chairs, tables, or other furniture are allowed in the benching areas or aisles of the show, and no chairs will be allowed in the crate and grooming areas.**
7. Handbills, circulars, or other printed matter may not be distributed at this show.
8. All cords on floor must be taped down to avoid tripping hazards.

BENCHING

1. Dogs are received only at the exhibitors' entrance, corner of 33rd St. & Pennsylvania Plaza between 7th and 8th Avenues, beginning at 6:00 A.M. E.T., each morning.
2. Dogs must arrive by 11:30 A.M. E.T. on the day they are judged. Dogs arriving after 11:30 A.M. E.T. will not be admitted, and no entry fees will be returned. All dogs must be removed from the benches by 11:30 P.M. E.T. Tuesday evening to the designated holding area. **TUESDAY BREEDS will not be admitted until 9:00 P.M. Monday evening.**
3. **Dogs and equipment cannot be removed from the show either day before 8:00 P.M. E.T.** Spectators buying items from concessionaires must show sales receipts to guards at the gates for any items they wish to take from the building before 8:00 P.M. E.T. All dogs must be removed from Madison Square Garden by midnight Tuesday. See Exhibitor Ticket Information #1 on page 18. See also separate note regarding release forms on page 4. **It is your responsibility to have the appropriate release forms to exit the building with dogs/equipment.**
4. Exhibitors wanting dogs of the same breed/variety benched together must have completed the benching form provided in the premium list and forwarded with the entries or as indicated in Entry Information item #12. It should be clearly understood that cancelling an entry in order to re-enter it with another is a violation of this provision and in such an instance the Superintendent would be under no obligation to bench the dogs together. **There will be no switching from breed section to multi-breed benching or vice-versa. There will be no switching between handlers' spaces. NO EXCEPTIONS.** ID's will state where dog is benched. It is your responsibility to send complete, correct information.

5. **Dogs of different breeds/varieties will be benched together provided they have the same agent and that agent has at least four (4) different breeds (not varieties) entered on each day they wish to be in the Multi-Breed area. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
6. Under no circumstances may exhibitors change their bench numbers.
7. Tape only may be used to attach signs and decorations to benches; that is, no nails, carpet tacks, thumb tacks, or staples may be used. All decorations must be fire-retardant. No signs over 11" x 14" may be displayed. No sign may exceed the top of the benching. No signs may be displayed on the bench other than a plaque or emblem of a show-giving Specialty Club to which the dog's owner belongs, or giving the kennel name & address of the owner. No prizes or ribbons shall be displayed on the bench except those won by the dog at this show. Benching sizes are as follows: Small 18w" x 32d"; medium, 23w" x 36d" and large, 31w" x 42d".
8. Chapter 13, Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows is strictly enforced. The benching of dogs is an integral part of the dog show, the importance of which cannot be overstated. **Exhibitors/Handlers who do not adhere to the benching requirements of the AKC and The Westminster Kennel Club as noted in this premium list run the risk of The Westminster Kennel Club refusing all future entries from you for their show.** In addition, dogs are presumed to be under the care custody and control of the person(s) listed on the entry form. Neglect of a dog on the bench could result in an Event Committee hearing. See also pages 4 & 14-20.

SPECIAL BENCHING NOTICE

Chapter 13, Section 1, of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows will be strictly enforced. IT IS PERMISSIBLE TO REMOVE A DOG FROM THE BENCH FOR A PERIOD OF 1 ½ HOURS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED TIME OF JUDGING SO THE DOG MAY BE GROOMED FOR THE RING. **DOGS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE BENCH WITHIN 30 MINUTES AFTER THEY ARE SHOWN.**

CITY LAWS

1. **The Director of the Bureau of Animal Affairs of New York City requires all dogs entering the City of New York to be accompanied by a Health Certificate issued by a licensed Veterinarian no more than 7 days prior to arrival in the City.**
2. New York City law states that people exercising dogs are responsible for cleaning-up the feces. The law is strictly enforced and punishable by a \$100.00 fine. The Department of Sanitation will be enforcing the "Pooper-Scooper" law and will be writing tickets for fines in the amount of \$100.00. Dog waste both inside and outside the building **MUST** be picked up and disposed of sanitarly. Failure to do so may result in an Event Committee hearing and/or refusal of future entries by this club.

SECURITY

1. ALL REQUESTS FOR THE HIRING OF PRIVATE GUARDS FOR THE WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB DOG SHOW MUST BE MADE THROUGH DOG SECURITY AT MADISON SQUARE GARDEN (212-631-5350) STARTING JANUARY 4, 2010, AND BEFORE NOON ON MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2010, FOR BOTH THE ORDER AND PAYMENT. THERE WILL BE A FIVE (5) AND EIGHT (8) HOUR SHIFT AND PAYMENT IN ADVANCE IS REQUIRED.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

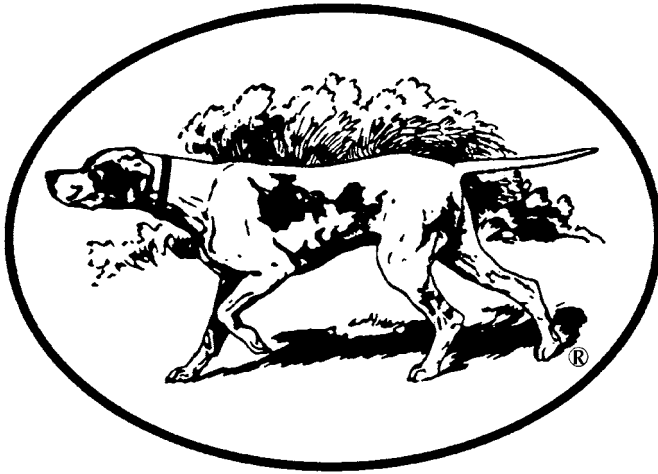
PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
